1. INTRODUCTION

The main objective of the Environmental and Social Risk Management Policy is to establish general guidelines for the incorporation of Environmental and Social Risk Analysis as part of comprehensive risk management, for the practical purpose of

controlling the effect on activities of companies taking credit and / or investment projects financed through Banco Supervielle, and to submit the Bank's own investments to an environmental and social impact assessment.

The initiatives launched pursue the following objectives:

- Reduce and control exposure to environmental and social risks with their financial impact given by the clients' activities, establishing a more active and systematic credit granting policy in the environmental and social impact analysis of companies and investment projects financed.
- Provide clients and investors the possibility of obtaining financing based on sustainable criteria.
- Promote good practices and environmental and social awareness among the bank's employees and customers, which promote sustainable development for society.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to Banco Supervielle, covering financial products granted to both the public and private sectors, as well as

environmental aspects associated with the procurement processes and management of the company's own facilities.

3. CONTEXT

For Banco Supervielle, its top objective is to consolidate itself as a sustainable organization from an environmental point of view. This implies recognizing the consequences derived from the development of one's own operational and commercial activities.

The initiative was launched in 2009 in connection with the agreement sealed with the FMO, and later with the agreements with IFC and IDB. In this way, Banco Supervielle joins a global movement in favor of sustainable development that recognizes the urgency of responding to the environmental and social crisis facing the world.

Banco Supervielle loan granting policy incorporates, on a systematic basis, protection and respect criteria for the Environment and Society, in all credit analysis operations to Corporate Banking clients and its reporting areas.

To this end, Banco Supervielle periodically monitors the Environmental and Social Risk profile. Senior Management and the Board of Directors receive pertinent information periodically that complements the active environmental risk management. As part of

this management, indicators are established to monitor the company's credit strategy, allowing it to adapt to acceptable levels of sustainability.

Banco Supervielle undertakes not to finance any company or investment project whose associated activity is considered as excluded by any multilateral organization through funds from said organization.

Additionally, it undertakes that companies related to gambling and tobacco do not have a stake greater than 1% of the total portfolio.

4. BASIS

This policy is aligned with the standards applied in other foreign and local financial entities that operate in Argentina, with the aim of streamlining and improving the analysis of Environmental and Social Risks. For its development, the concepts of the ARAS Methodology and the standards of the International Finance Corporation (hereinafter "IFC") were taken, which contributes in its sections 1 to 8 in Performance Standards for the Preparation of the principles of Ecuador; Netherlands Development Finance Company (hereinafter "FMO") and the Inter-American Development Bank (hereinafter "IDB").

Pillar I - Responsible Financing

In accordance with our values, assuming commitment, honor and responsibility to the community and shareholders, at Banco Supervielle we understand that compliance with environmental and social aspects is essential when granting a loan.

In this sense, Banco Supervielle decided to implement an internal methodology, particularly considering as Pillar I, the inclusion of environmental and social risk

management as part of credit analysis. It is based on aspects developed in the ARAS Methodology.

Banco Supervielle is committed to ensuring reduction and mitigation of negative impacts on ecosystems and communities, granting credits only to those companies / investment projects that can verify adequate management of their social or environmental impacts and / or verify plans to mitigate them, in areas such as:

- Biodiversity protection
- Use of renewable resources
- Waste management
- Human health protection
- Population displacement
- Occupational Health and Safety
- Mitigation of climate change
- Gender equality
- Non tolerance of discrimination based on religious, political, social, race or sexual orientation grounds
- Respect and preserve the culture, knowledge and practices of indigenous peoples
- Protection of cultural heritage

As part of said commitment based on responsible financing, a series of activities excluded from granting of financing are defined. See detail in Annex I of this document.

In order to apply the Environmental and Social Risks methodology, all those credit requests made by companies that exceed or equal an annual billing amount of AR\$

100MM as well as their granted plafond exceed AR\$ 60MM will be considered.

In the cases in which investment projects are presented to be financed by Banco Supervielle, the Non-Financial Risk Department will carry out a particular evaluation of the same in order to determine application of socio-environmental risk methodology, following the guidelines established in the present policy based on the magnitude, scope and activities associated with said project.

5. APPLICATION

As part of the obligations of Banco Supervielle client companies, they will be required to adhere to this policy by means of the contractual statement established by the Business Legal Advice Department.

The borrowing companies undertake to provide Banco Supervielle with all the documentation required to monitor the situation status and verify the result of their actions in terms of environmental and social risks, being in line with the provisions of the clauses of the signed credit agreement.

The identification of the industry / activity in which the borrowing company is framed, as well as the classification obtained regarding the level of inherent impact, must be exposed within the usual documentation required for the preparation of the client file by the Business Banking official.

Once a decision to proceed with the credit granting is made, once results have been obtained and analyzed according to the classification and categorization of residual risk detailed in the Environmental and Social Risk Management procedure, the identified risks as well as existing actions and/or the actions to be developed by the credit-taking

company for its treatment and mitigation must be documented.

The residual risk categorization may be HIGH, MEDIUM, LOW or VERY LOW and the corresponding monitoring must be carried out by the Bank, updating the situation statement and verifying the result of said actions with a minimum annual frequency (in the case of HIGH Risk) and a minimum biannual frequency (in the case of MEDIUM Risk companies).

The Bank has determined the following company classification by virtue of their associated activity and in accordance with the adopted methodology:

Type 1: Companies and / or investment projects whose associated industry / activity has the potential to cause significant negative or adverse inherent environmental impacts and associated social effects or has profound implications that affect natural resources.

Type 2: Companies and / or investment projects whose associated industry / activity may cause mainly inherent negative localized and short-term environmental

impacts of a moderate level, including associated social impacts.

Type 3: Companies and / or investment projects whose associated industry / activity does not cause inherent negative environmental impacts, including associated social ones, or whose impacts are minimal or null.

If the industry / activity associated with the borrowing company is not among those pre-classifieds under Type 1 or Type 2 (See ANNEX II), it will be considered as:

Type 3: Companies and / or investment projects whose associated industry / activity does not cause inherent negative environmental impacts, including associated social ones, or whose impacts are minimal or null.

Among the industries / activities of this type are considered:

- Software development
- Service Industries
- Manufacturing companies
- Technical assistance
- Stock records
- Consulting Firms
- Stock market agencies
- Retail banking
- Insurance Companies
- Other Industries / Activities not categorized in ANNEX II

Pillar II – “Green Projects” Promotion

In line with the principle promoted by Banco Supervielle for the commitment of its clients with the protection and conservation of the environment, and the improvement of social conditions, as well as the company's objective of being part of a more business / financial sector committed to

sustainable development, Pillar II of this policy establishes the identification and financing of "Green Projects" considering as such those through which positive environmental / social impacts can be determined and evidenced, development of renewable energies, among others.

Pillar III - Internal Policy for the Environment Care

Banco Supervielle is aware of its commitment to caring for the environment, for which it promotes the implementation of measures focused on the prevention, control and mitigation of environmental aspects and impacts generated from its own operations.

In the same way as the rest of this policy, the definitions of Pillar III have been established by Senior Management and apply, in this case, to all officers and employees of the company, including personnel who work as temporary and / or contractors.

The Risk Management Department will provide support and advice to implement and execute the defined policies.

Additionally, Banco Supervielle makes the Ethics & Values Line available to employees and suppliers so that any employee or supplier who is aware of any fact that allegedly violates this policy can report this situation.

ANNEX I - Environmental and Social Risks - Excluded Activities

- Production, trade, activities that involve ways of work that are not under the Argentine laws or regulations.
- Manufacture or trafficking of arms and ammunition.
- Trade in species of wild flora and fauna threatened or regulated by CITES 4 or products derived from them.
- Manufacture or sale of radioactive materials.
- Production, trade or use of amiantone agglomerate fibers.
- Plantation projects that would require the removal of non-degraded natural forest areas.
- Manufacture or sale of products with PCB.
- Cross-border trade in waste or waste products, except non-hazardous waste for recycling.
- Production or trade of pharmaceutical specialties subject to staggered withdrawal or prohibition at the international level.
- Production or trade in substances that deplete the ozone layer subject to phase-out at the international level.
- Fishing with gillnets and drift in the marine environment with trawl nets.
- Production or trade of pesticides or herbicides subject to phased withdrawal or prohibition at the national and international level and persistent organic pollutants "POPs" (Wetted Herbicides).

Restricted Activities:

In the case of Tobacco and Gambling companies, it will be controlled that they do not exceed the percentage of the total portfolio (0.5%).

Health, **Media**, Non-Profit Organizations will be controlled that they do not exceed the percentage of the total portfolio (2%) - RESTRICTED BY CREDIT RISK
